

12. Letter to Antoine De Lange April 14, 1805

Adelaïde will have the opportunity to attend a Mass of the Pope in St Sulpice at the end of December, and then will be received in audience in March 1805 at the Convent of the Annunciation. The Holy Father assures him 'that he received the Writings of Fr. de Clorivière.

“The Holy Father perfectly welcomed our report; he had not forgotten anything of what he had done for us, and he spoke of the work in a very advantageous and appropriate way to encourage us and to convince us more and more that he approved of it and that he looked upon it as the work of God. This is all we could desire to make sure that we are in the plan of God and considered favorably by the Head of the Church. He particularly welcomed the one he knew to be at the head of the Society of Heart of Mary, and he made her hold a precious relic. He gave distinguished marks of goodwill to our deputy in Rome who always remained faithful to us when he made himself known to him.”
