The Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary to which you are consecrated will give themselves to you. By this mark the Blessed Trinity will recognize you as a favoured portion of its domain, and nothing will tear you away from its hands.

These Hearts will be a treasure always open where you will find every virtue that you need, every gift that you desire, a remedy for every ill. Here will be superabundant satisfaction for all debts that you may owe to divine justice, an inexhaustible treasure. The more spiritual riches you draw from them the more you will find for yourselves and for others.

These Hearts will be a sure refuge, a strong rampart behind which you can shelter from your enemies. They are an invisible oratory hidden from all but the heavenly Father's eye, where far from creatures and in the heart of the divinity, you will ask great things in the name of Christ and in union with Him.
